

How to Enable Closed-Captioned in English with Google Chrome

To watch a live stream on YouTube with closed-captioned (CC) in English, please follow the below instructions. (For use with Google Chrome only.)

- Make sure your Google Chrome browser is up-to-date by clicking on the three-dot menu (or kebab menu) in the top right corner of your browser. Follow instructions if relaunch is needed.
- Once updated, click again on the three-dot menu and click SETTINGS at the bottom
 of the pop-up menu that appears. This will open a new tab called SETTINGS in your
 browser.
- In the SETTINGS left-side menu, click ADVANCED and then ACCESSIBILITY.
- In the ACCESSIBILITY options, turn on the first item called LIVE CAPTION using the toggle. Once LIVE CAPTION is turned on, you may exit the SETTINGS.
- After that, anytime you view a live video, Google will display a dark gray rectangle window in the bottom center of your screen with the CC running. You can close the CC window using the X or move it around on your screen as needed.
